**Important Notice**

In the light of Health Department, Govt. of Bihar, letter no. सं.सं. 1/प.मि. - 04/2020(पाठे-II) 623(1) dt. 26.06.2020 and 672(1) dated 10.07.2020, provision has been made for granting incentives marks maximum up to 30% in terms of regulation 9(iv) issued by the Medical Council of India vide notification no. MCI-18(1)/2010-Med/62052 dt. 15.02.2012 as amended vide notification no. MCI-18(1)/2018-Med/100818 dt. 05.01.2018 and regulation 7(2) issued by DCI notification no. DE-87-2017 dt. 05.11.2017 as amended in terms of 2nd amendment notification published on 18.09.2018 in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) to the Medical Officer (Medical as well as Dental) who is in Service of Bihar Govt./ Public Authority and has work experience of working in remote / difficult area notified by Health Deptt., Government of Bihar vide Notification no. सं.सं. 2/कोटे-59/13 1037(2)/Health dt. 27.08.2013.

2. In the light of above letters and notifications of Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar, the revised prospectus of PGMAC-2020 has been uploaded on Board's website.

3. In the light of above, this is to inform all PGMAC-2020 candidates and all concerned that the candidate who have duly filled Online Application of PGMAC-2020 on the basis of NEET(PG)-2020 vide Adv. No.-BCECEB(PGMAC)-2020/01 & 2020/02 dated 17.04.2020 and BCECEB(PGMAC)-2020/03 dated 21.04.2020 and claimed Reservation for Serving as Medical Officer in Remote / Difficult area as "Yes" has to upload work experience certificate for working in remote / difficult area notified by Health Deptt., Govt. of Bihar vide above mentioned notification. They are advised to visit the Board's website: bceceboard.bihar.gov.in and follow the steps as mentioned therein.

4. Those candidates who have duly filled Online Application Form of PGMAC-2020 on the basis of NEET (MDS)-2020 through above mentioned Advertisement and wants to claim the weightage of Marks for serving as Medical Officer (Dental) in remote / difficult area have also to follow the steps as mentioned in Para-1 & 5.

5. All concerned NEET(PG) / NEET(MDS)-2020 candidates are advised to click the Link "**Online Application Portal of PGMAC-2020**" as per the programme given in para-10 and Click "Apply Online" button and login to account by entering registered Email ID and Password by clicking "Sign in" button. After successful login, click on "**Application for M.O. Employed candidates**" button and fill the required informations as asked on the screen and upload the required experience certificate (**See Annexure-3 & 3A of PGMAC-2020 Prospectus**). Click on "Save" button. Candidates are also advised to download or take a print out of filled application for further use. If any candidates fails to upload the remote area experience certificate, he/she will not be considered for Reservation for Remote / difficult area.

6. Qualified, eligible & interested NEET(PG)-2020 and NEET(MDS)-2020 candidates who are eligible for granting weightage marks as per MCI / DCI above regulation for work experience for working in remote / difficult area notified by Health Deptt., Govt. of Bihar vide Notification no. सं.सं. 2/कोटे-59/13 1037(2)/Health dt. 27.08.2013 and is in service of Bihar Government / Public Authority and have not filled online application for PGMAC-2020 earlier, are being given a chance to fill the Online Application form for PGMAC-2020 as per the programme given in para-10.

7. As per Dental Council of India letter no. DE-NEET(MDS) Admission-2020/761 dt. 03.07.2020, the cut-off pre fixed qualifying percentile has been lowered down. Candidates of NEET(MDS)-2020 who have not filled up online application of PGMAC-2020 either due to any reason or could not fill up due to pre fixed qualifying cut-off percentile, they can also fill online application form of PGMAC-2020 as per the programme given in para-10.

8. If any qualified, eligible and interested NEET(PG)-2020 have not filled up online application form of PGMAC-2020 due to any reason, they can also fill online application form of PGMAC-2020 as per the programme given in para-10.

9. Instructions for filling the online application form can be obtained from the Adv. No.- BCECEB(PGMAC)-2020/02 dated 17.04.2020 uploaded on board's website.
