As per the letter no. सं.सं.-1/प.नि.-05/2026-1017 (1) dated 03.08.2026 of the Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar the nominations or allotment of seats for admission in various Post Graduate Dental courses including PG Dental (MDS) shall be made according to merit-cum-choice on the basis of the Competitive Test as conducted by National Board of Examination, New Delhi i.e. NEET (MDS)-2026.

1. SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT :

- (i) This Prospectus may be called 'Post Graduate Dental Admission Counselling Prospectus-2026.
- (ii) It shall extend to the whole of the State of Bihar.
- (iii) It shall come into force at once.

2. DEFINITIONS :

- (i) 'College'—Means Dental Colleges in the State of Bihar.
- (ii) 'Course'—Means Post Graduate Dental courses of study i.e. PG Dental (MDS) Courses.
- (iii) 'Examination'— NEET (MDS)-2026.
- (iv) 'Board'— Means Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, Government of Bihar.
- (v) 'Government'— Means State Government of Bihar.
- (vi) 'Controller of Examination'- Means Controller of Examination, Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, appointed by the Government.
- (vii) 'He' includes 'She'.
- (viii) 'Bihar' - Means Bihar after reorganisation as defined under section-4 of the Bihar Reorganisation Act-2000.

3. Admission Test :

Nomination for admission in PG Dental (MDS) Courses shall be made on merit-cum-choice basis on NEET (MDS)-2026 conducted by National Board of Examination as provided in this prospectus.

4. Institutions / Available seats (MDS courses) in Govt. & Private Dental Colleges (Tentative) :

Institution / course / subject / category wise seat matrix is available as Table-1A & 1B.

- Note :** i. The allotments of candidates for admission against recognised seats available in Private Dental Colleges of the state of Bihar will be made.
- ii. As against permitted seats available in Private Dental Colleges the allotment will be made subject to decision of the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and consequent directives of the Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
 - iii. The details regarding courses / institution for allotment against MDS seats of Private Dental Colleges will be made available at the time of Counselling.
 - iv. For allotment of MDS seats in Private Dental Colleges, the reservation policy, as communicated by the Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar will not be applicable but instead the reservation arrangement in the concerned Institution will be applicable and the same will be made known at the time of counselling.

- v. Fee structure & other details regarding admission to MDS (Dental) courses in Private Dental Colleges will be informed by the representative of the concerned private Institutions.
- vi. Duration of MDS courses shall be of 2/3 years duration.

5. QUALIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY FOR MDS (Master of Dental Surgery) COURSE GROUP :

5.1 Educational :

- (i) The candidates must have passed the BDS Examination from any recognised Dental College of Bihar State included in the schedule of Dental Council of India. For Private Dental Colleges, this criteria is liable to be modified in the light of ज्ञापक सं.- 1/विविध-74/2016-404(1) दिनांक 06.04.2019 and related directives of Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
- (ii) The candidates who are permanent residents of Bihar and have been admitted in BDS course on the basis of competitive examination conducted on behalf of Govt. of Bihar or by CBSE (under All India Quota) before the bifurcation of Bihar i.e. 15.11.2000 in Dental Colleges situated in Jharkhand and have obtained the degree of BDS are also eligible for appearing in this competitive examination for admission in academic session 2026 in this Course Group.
- (iii) The candidates must have completed the rotating Internship on or before 31.05.2026 as per the provision contained in the Information bulletin of NEET(MDS)-2026.
- (iv) The candidates must have obtained Registration from Bihar State Dental Council or Dental Council of India. A candidate, who has not obtained permanent registration from Bihar State Dental Council or Dental Council of India but is otherwise eligible, may be allowed to appear at PGDAC-2026 on provisional basis but he must obtain the same within one month from the date of his admission in P.G. Dental Course as per the rules of the Dental Council of India, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled. He must also be registered after admission under the concerned University within the period prescribed by that University.

5.2 Residential :

The candidates must be a citizen of India.

5.3 Others :

A candidate who is not a permanent resident of Bihar but has passed the BDS Examination from any Dental Colleges of Bihar State included in the Schedule of Dental Council of India, is also eligible.

5.4 Age limit :

There is no maximum age limit for appearing PG Dental Counselling 2026.

5.5 No objection certificate :

A candidate who is in employment either in Government or elsewhere will be allowed to appear at the PG Dental Counselling 2026 only if he produces a certificate of "no objection" from his employer with the condition that if selected he will be granted study leave to pursue the course. However a candidate who is an employee of Government of Bihar shall be issued admit card provisionally in the absence of such "no objection" certificate. But on selection, he will have to produce relieving certificate from his controlling officer. Otherwise, he is required to furnish an undertaking/ affidavit that in case he is selected he shall resign from the service and shall undertake the studies as a full time student. Such affidavit/ undertaking is to be filed along with the application form. The relieving letter by the employer shall be submitted on or before the date of admission.

5.6 Training :

- (i) The MDS course Group Candidates called for counselling / Interview, if selected, shall have to be registered with Bihar Dental Council / Dental Council of India within one month from the date of the admission in MDS Course and will also have to be registered by the University concerned within the prescribed period by that University. The registered candidates will undergo whole time training during the entire period for completing the MDS Course.
- (ii). The compulsory Rotatory Internship must be from Institution approved and recognised by the Dental Council of India or any University duly recognised by the Government of Bihar.
- (iii). No admission or readjustment will be done after the last date of admission as fixed in compliance with the requirement of Dental Council of India. Thereafter the seats remaining vacant if any, shall be treated to have lapsed. No transfer / migration will be permissible after admission.
- (iv). An admitted candidate on the basis of counselling of PGDAC-2026 shall automatically forfeit his claim to continue in the previous MDS Course. His name registered for that MDS Course will be

cancelled and upon his admission to the new MDS Course on the basis of PGDAC-2026, he will have to get registered with the university concerned for that MDS Course only and he has to refund the entire amount of stipend already paid to him for the previous MDS Course to the previous Institution and a certificate to this effect is to be produced at the time of counselling to the new MDS Course, allowed to him.

- (v). Admitted candidates who remain absent continuously for more than 2 months are liable to forfeit their candidature.

6. RESERVATION :

- (A) (i) For the selection of candidates for admission in PG Dental Course in Govt. Dental Colleges, the reservation Policy/ Rules of the Government of Bihar prevailing on the date of Online submission of Application Forms for PG Dental Counselling 2026 will be applicable.

Accordingly the reservation categories will be determined on the basis of the lists of SC, ST, EBC and BC as approved by the Govt. of Bihar and applicable on the date of the online submission of application forms for allotment of PG Dental seats on the basis of PG Dental Counselling based on NEET (MDS)-2026.

- (ii) For the Candidates, who are permanent residents of Bihar State, reservation of seats for various Categories as per the policy of the Government of Bihar prevailing at the date of PG Dental Counselling 2026 is as given below –

<u>SN</u>	<u>Category</u>	<u>Reserved Seats (% of Total Seats)</u>
1.	Schedule Caste (SC)	16%
2.	Schedule Tribe (ST)	01%
3.	Extremely Backward Caste (EBC)	18%
4.	Backward Caste (BC)	12%
5.	Reserve Category Girls (RCG)	03%
6.	Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10 %

The remaining 40% unreserved seats will be considered as Unreserved (UR) Category seats.

- Note : (a) 10% Reservation for Economically Weaker Section will be provided as per the Extra Ordinary Gazatte of Bihar, Patna dated 26.02.2019.
- (b) Without affecting the provisions of vertical reservations, as applicable from time to time for admission in the educational Institutions in the Sate of Bihar, one third of total seats of all the courses and categoris in each Institution and College affiliated with the University shall be horizontally reserved for admission of women candidates. In case of Post-Graduate courses it shall be applied at the State level specialty wise.

Provided that this benefit shall be available only to the women domiciled in the State of Bihar. In the absence of eligible women candidate, the vacant seats in the same academic session shall be filled up by the male candidates from the relevant category (reserved / unreserved).

- (iii) For the Candidates who are not the permanent resident of the State of Bihar, seats earmarked for the reserved categories as enumerated in Sl. No. 6(ii) above, will not be admissible, vide Department of General Administration, Governemnt of Bihar letter no. 11/आ०-विविध-50/2011 सा०- 2710 dated 26.08.2011. They will be considered against General Category seats only.
- (iv) Candidates of reserved categories competing in General Merit List will not be counted against reserved category seats. Selection of the candidates in the unreserved category will also be on merit. Placement of Reserved Category candidates will be done as per the Government resolution/ orders applicable at the time of starting the sales of the Application Form for PG Dental Counselling 2026. Candidates of reserved category competing in General Merit List will have the option for general as well as the concerned reserved category seats for purposes of placements, but the seat of reserved category exhausted due to their option will be compensated from seats of General Merit List.
- (v) A candidate claiming admission on seats reserved for SC/ ST/ EBC/ BC / EWS will have to furnish (a) Residential certificate (b) Caste certificate from C.O. / Revenue Officer of the area of his/her permanent residence in the State of Bihar, as mentioned in the Application Form for appearing in PG DentalCounselling 2026.

- N.B. :**(i) Caste and Residential Certificates issued by other than C.O. / Revenue Officer will not be entertained and will lead to rejection of his/ her application.
The Residential Certificate must mention that the candidate is a permanent resident (स्थायी निवासी) of Bihar giving his complete address, letter no. and date of issue. Certificates mentioning that the candidate is resident (निवासी) / temporary resident (अस्थायी निवासी) or incomplete in any respect will not be accepted.
- (ii) Caste certificate issued on the basis of the Caste of the Husband / Wife of the candidate is not acceptable. Caste Certificate issued on the basis of the caste of his / her father will only be accepted.
- (iii) The spelling of the name of the candidate written in his application form of NEET (MDS)-2026 must be the same as written in his matriculation and other certificates. Any difference will subject to the decision of the concerned authority of the Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
- (vi) The category, which a candidate claims for reservation in the space provided for this purpose in the Application Form and the Residential certificate and Caste certificate which he submits as per para (v) above, will be accepted for the PG DentalCounselling 2026 and the allotment of seats will be made on that basis provided the same are in conformity with the rank list of NEET (MDS)-2026. Once the application form is accepted, no change will be allowed. In case the category claimed by a candidate and mentioned in the specified space in application form for appearing in counselling differs from that mentioned in the merit list as provided by the Deptt. of Health, Govt of Bihar based on NEET (MDS)-2026, then the category as mentioned in the Merit List will be treated as final. If a candidate does not mention the category at the specified space in application form or does not submit the proper caste certificate in support of his claim for the reserved category benefit then he will be treated in General (GEN) i.e. UR (Unreserved) category. The responsibility of losing his reservation claim due to his mistake/ carelessness will entirely be his own.

(B) Reserved Seats under Disabled Quota (DQ) :

- (a) For disabled candidates, 5% out of the available seats in each Institution, are reserved under "Disable Quota". Such reserved seats are included in the total number of the available seats.
In this connection, if the state Government issues any other Government order before publishing the merit list for counselling / interview for the purposes of the seat allotment, then reservation rules according to the same Government order, will be applicable for admission under Disable Quota subject to his DQ (or PH) status is mentioned in merit list of NEET (MDS)-2026.
- (b) To participate in the counselling of PGDAC-2026, candidates belonging to the Disabled Quota must mentioned DQ in the prescribed space in their application form, which confirms their Disability (PH or (DQ) status in the merit list of NEET (MDS)-2026. Such DQ candidates are required to upload the Disability Certificate in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-2) issued by the designated Medical Colleges / Institutes mentioned in Annexure-3 & Annexure-4 of the brochure after the disability test in the light of regulation on Graduate Medical Education (1997) as amended upto 14.05.2019 or in the prescribed proforma of the Information Bulletin of NEET (MDS)-2026, alongwith the UDID Card and Affidavit by the candidate and the same will be required to submitted in original at the time of Document Verification.
- (c) "Guidelines for admission against Disable Quota" is enclosed as Annexure - I.

7. Procurement for application form, prospectus and counselling fee & security deposit:

- 7.1.** The Prospectus for appearing in PGDAC-2026 can be downloaded Online from the BCECE Board's website: bceceboard.bihar.gov.in by clicking on the link **"PGDAC-2026"** under Prospectus Section. **For filling Online Application Form & Choices** click on **"Online portal of PGDAC-2026"** and follow the instructions as given below;

i. Step-One (Registration) :

For Registration, candidate will have to authenticate their identity by giving NEET (MDS)-2026 Roll No., Candidate's Name and Date of Birth as appearing on the computer screen. After Identity / Data authentication, an OTP will be sent to candidate's registered Mobile No. and Email Address as provided during submission of NEET (MDS)-2026 Application Form invited by NBEMS. No request will be

entertained to change / update the Mobile No. / Email Address throughout of the session before / after successful Registration. While doing the registration for filling the online application form, he / she is also required to create password. After successful submission of the Registration details an PGDAC ID will be generated and it will be used to complete the remaining steps of the application form and will also be required for all future reference / correspondence. To complete the remaining steps of the application form candidate will have to login their account by entering their NEET (MDS)-2026 Roll No. & Password and will process the further activities to duly submit their Online Application Form. The candidate must keep the password confidential, otherwise BCECE Board will not be responsible for any consequences..

ii. Step-Two (Multi-Step Application Form) :

(a) Personal Information :

After successful registration, the candidate should again "Sign in" to his account and thereafter complete the required entries regarding personal information appeared on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.

(b) Contact Details :

After successful completion of Personal Information candidate have to submit their Permanent and Correspondence Address as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.

(c) Educational Information :

After successful completion of Contact Details candidate have to submit their Educational Information as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.

(d) Employment Details :

After successful completion of Educational Information candidate have to submit their Employment Details as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.

(e) Other Details :

After successful completion of Employment Details candidate have to submit their Other Details as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.

(f) Upload Photo, Signature & Required Documents (if any) :

After successful completion of Educational Information candidate have to upload the Scanned copy of their highly contrast Colour Photograph, Signature & Required Documents (if any) at appropriate place as per the instructions provided on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button. (For further details kindly refer to the instructions uploaded on application portal regarding Photo & Signature uploading.)

iii. Step-Three (Application Preview & Final Submit) :

Candidates are advised to check their entries provided in Step-1 & Step-2 of the application form and if found any anomalies, click on "Back to Edit" button and rectify it. After rectification click on "Save & Continue" button so that the entries provided by them could get updated.

If all the informations provided during filling of Online Application found to be OK on the preview page, click on "Final Submit & Proceed to Payment" button by giving the declaration and pay the Counselling Fee & Security Deposit as per instruction provided in Step-Four. If candidates does not do the final submission of the application form and payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit within prescribed date & time, then their filled up application form will get rejected, for which candidate will be himself solely responsible and no any request will be entertained regarding this.

iv. Step-Four (Payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit) :

After clicking "Final Submit & Proceed to Payment" button, complete the payment procedure according to instructions appeared on the computer screen regarding payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit. **Paid Counselling Fee is not refundable.**

Online Payment : Candidate will have to pay the Counselling Fee & Security Deposit through Online mode only i.e. Debit Card / Credit Card / Net banking/ UPI, The candidate has to pay processing charge additional to Counselling Fee & Security Deposit for payment through online mode.

(a) Candidate has to pay Rs. 2200/- (Two Thousand Two Hundred Only) for all category as non refundable counselling/registration fee through online mode only e.g. by Credit card/Debit Card/ Net Banking / UPI.

(b) The details of payment of security deposit for Govt. / Pvt. Dental Colleges will be as follows ;

As per above table, the candidate has to pay the refundable security deposit, if applicable, through online mode only e.g. by Credit card/Debit Card/ Net Banking / UPI at the time of registration and submission of the application form. The candidate has also to pay processing charge in addition to Counselling Fee & Security Deposit for payment through online mode.

Note: (i) If the amount paid as Counselling Fee & Security Deposit is debited from your account but the fee transaction fails, then in such case you must re-pay the desired full fee and ensure the payment. If your required Counselling fee & Security Deposit do not reflect in Board's account within the due date, your application form will remain incomplete and will be rejected due to which will not be eligible

for participating in the counselling process.

Your failed transaction will be refunded to your account in due course.

v. Step-Five (Choice Filling) :

After successful payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit candidate have to fill Choices of course and Institution / Colleges in order of preference. Candidate will have to click on "**Save Choices**" link and after then click on "**Choice Locking**" link to lock their filled up choices before scheduled last date and time. If candidate lock their choices and again want to edit their filled up choices, then candidate may modify their choices by clicking "**Unlock Choices**" link by authentication through their password and OTP sent on their registered Mobile No. / Email ID. Candidates are advised to Lock their filled up choices before scheduled last date and time so that they could download or print their filled up and submitted choices. If candidate click on "**Save Choices**" link but does not lock their filled up choices within scheduled last date and time, their choices will get automatically locked after last date and time of choice filling. Candidate will be allowed to download or take a print of their filled up choices after locking of choices only.

Note : Choice Locking & Unlocking process will be done through OTP authentication only which will be sent on Registered Mobile No. / Email ID of the candidate. **The candidate must not that their Registered Mobile No. and Email ID can not be changed in any circumstances.**

vi. Step-Six (Download Confirmation Page & Fee Receipt) :

After successful payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit, candidates are advised to download the Confirmation Page & Fee Receipt and re-verify the entries printed on the confirmation page. **If found any discrepancy it may be corrected during the time of Registration and submission of Application Form-cum-Choice Filling** as per schedule mentioned in "**Important Dates**". Finally download the Confirmation Page for future use.

vii. Step-Seven (Download Choice Slip) :

After successful submission and locking of filled up choices candidate may download or take a print of their filled up choices by clicking "**View Filled Choices**" link available on PGDAC-2026 portal dashboard.

viii. Editing / Correction of Application Form Data:

- (i) The above-mentioned editing / rectification / correction opportunity will be available for only those candidates, who have successfully filled their online application form and made the payment successfully within due date.
- (ii) For making rectification / correction / editing in online submitted application, the candidate will have to login to his / her account using their Roll No. & Password provided during the time of Registration. After successful login candidate will click on the link "**Edit your Online Filled Application Form**". Candidate will have to give their consent to Edit / Correct their previous filled Application Form data which will be authenticated through their password and OTP sent on their registered Mobile No. / Email ID. If OTP gets verified, the candidate will be able to edit/correct their filled-up Application Form data and do the following;
 - (a) Candidate may either edit/correct any data of his/her Application Form or not edit/correct any data of his/her Application Form but will have to save the Application Form finally by clicking "**Final Submit**" button visible on the Preview page of the Application. After Successful submission / Successful updating of payment status on application server, the edited Application Form will be treated as final. The filled-up choices will not get "**Null & Void**" and candidate will have the facility to edit the filled-up choices and will save the choices by clicking "**Save Choices**" link and after that to lock the choices by clicking "**Choice Locking**" link so that printout of finally filled-up and submitted choices could be obtained with proper validation of choices as per eligibility of finally submitted edited data.
 - (b)
 - (i) If candidate either edit/correct any data of his/her Application Form or does not edit/correct any data of his/her Application Form and does not save the Application Form finally by clicking "**Final Submit**" button visible on the Preview page of the Application, then Application Form will be treated as incomplete and will not be eligible for seat allotment process.
 - (ii) If candidate edit/correct any data of his/her Application Form **due to which additional fee payment condition arises** then candidate has to pay the required fees but if he/she does not pay the required fee by saving the Application Form finally by clicking "**Final Submit**" button visible on the Preview page of the Application, then Application Form will be treated as incomplete and will not be eligible for seat allotment process.

If candidate finally submit the Application Form successfully in the light of above process, candidate will have the facility to edit the filled-up choices and to save the choices by clicking "**Save Choices**" link and after that to lock the choices by clicking "**Choice Locking**" link so that printout of finally filled-up and submitted choices could be obtained with proper validation of choices as per eligibility of finally submitted edited data.

- (c) Due to Editing / Correction of data, if any additional Fee payment condition arises then candidate will have to re-pay the desired full-fee of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit afresh and ensure the payment. Such candidate's previously paid amount of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit will be refunded back to their account through the same mode by which they had done the payment.
- (iii) After successful submission of edited Application Form and Filling/Editing of Choices, candidate will have to lock their choices so that they could download or print their filled-up choices.

On the basis of AIR obtained in NEET(MDS)-2026, Rank Card of all eligible candidates who will fill Online Application Form and pay the Counselling Fee & Security Deposit in between 20.08.2026 to 24.08.2026 will be uploaded on Board's website "bceceboard.bihar.gov.in" on 26.08.2026. Candidates are advised to download their Rank Card of PGDAC-2026 by clicking the link "**Rank Card of PGDAC-2026**" by submitting their PGDAC ID and Date of Birth.
- xi. a. The candidates are required to fill up the reservation category very carefully taking into consideration the reservation policy/ rules / category as specified and applicable in the State of Bihar on the date of starting the process of online submission of the prescribed application form for PGDAC-2026. Details of Reservation Rule may be seen in Para-6 of PGDAC-2026 Prospectus.
- b. Confirmation Page (Application Form) need not to be send to Board's office, but instead this is to be made available at the time of counselling.
- c. After completing the above procedure and after the date of editing and submitting the online application form, there is no provision for any change or modification in the same.

- b) There will be four (4) round of Counselling i.e. Round-1, Round-2, Round-3 and Stray Vacancy Round.
- c) All round Counselling i.e. Round-1, Round-2, Round-3 and Stray Vacancy round will be Online.
- d) For Round-3 Online Counselling Fresh online Registration & submission of Application Form, from those candidates who have not Registered and submitted Application Form of PGDAC-2026 earlier i.e. before 1st round Counselling, will be taken. Details will be made available through concerned advertisement.

8.2 (i) (a) Updated rules, directives and procedure of DCI / NMC / MCC for each Round of Counselling will be followed.

- (b) Candidates are advised to visit official BCECE Board <https://bceceboard.bihar.gov.in/> website regularly for latest updates.

ii. For admission in reserve categories, all Institutions will be considered as one unit.

iii. The candidates belonging to unreserved category have to secure at least 50 percentile marks and candidates belonging to SC, ST, EBC & BC reserve categories at least 40th percentile marks in the competitive test of NEET (MDS)-2026, in order to fulfil the minimum performance criterion as fixed by the National Medical Council to be eligible for admission in any Post Graduate course.

vi. No candidate will be permitted to pursue and complete more than one course from the same Examination [NEET (MDS)-2026] and the same session.

vii. No candidate will be enrolled for two courses simultaneously i.e., as a regular student for one course and as an ex-student for the other course.

viii. If a candidate has been admitted in a P.G. Dental courses in any speciality on the basis of an earlier P.G. Dental Admission Test, then he may be allowed to appear at the current P.G. Dental counselling but will not be eligible for admission in a P.G. Dental course of another speciality unless:-

- (a) He resigns and vacates the seat of P.G. Dental courses of against which he / has been admitted earlier, within seven days of receiving of the allotment / nomination order on the basis of current PG Dental Counselling based on NEET (MDS)-2026.
- (b) He returns all the pecuniary benefits taken thereof for the earlier course.
- (c) He is liable to pay compensation for leaving the earlier course if the final decision regarding the same is made by the Government before the commencement of the counselling based on the current PG Dental Counselling based on NEET (MDS)-2026.

9. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :**

- (i) Any candidate if reported to have committed unfair means / impersonation at any stage during the process of selection for PG Dental course, shall be liable for legal action at any stage before or after admission under Bihar conduct of Examination Act, 1981 and other relevant Acts. Under the provisions the candidate may be expelled and debarred from appearing in the process of nomination for a seat of PG Dental Course.

As per Bihar Conduct of Examination Act-1981, "Unfair Means" in relation to any examination shall mean taking or giving or attempting to take or give help from any material written or printed or from any person in any form whatsoever.

- (ii) Submission of incorrect/ false documents / informations and adoption of unfair means/ impersonation, if detected at any stage after the selection for admission at any later stage shall automatically lead to rejection of the candidature of the candidate for admission.
- (iii) The candidates whose Roll / Name appeared in the merit list based on NEET (MDS)-2026 will have to appear in person at his own cost for scrutiny and verification of the original documents/ his identity and for Interview/ Counselling on the scheduled date and time, failing which his claim for allotment of a seat will be rejected. It is to be noted that Interview / Counselling is being conducted as per the directives of the Department of Health, Government of Bihar.
- (iv) Appearance in person for scrutiny of original certificate / documents during Interview/ Counselling does not entitle a candidate for allotment / admission.

1. (i) These Regulations may be called the “Graduate Medical Education Regulations, (Amendment), 2019”.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the “Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997”, in Appendix “H” - Guidelines regarding admission of students with “Specified Disabilities” under the Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MBBS –shall be substituted with Appendix “H-1”.

- Note : 1. The “Certificate of Disability” shall be issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 15th June 2017.
2. The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016)” notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 4th January 2018.
3. The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability.
4. **The term ‘Persons with Disabilities’ (PwD) is to be used instead of the term ‘Physically Handicapped’ (PH).**
