1. परिचय :

स्वास्थ्य विभाग, बिहार सरकार के ज्ञापांक- सं.सं.-1/प.नि.-04/2026-432(1) दिनांक 27.04.2026 के आलोक में बिहार राज्य के चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों के एम.बी.बी.एस. / बी.डी.एस. एवं डेयरी, मत्स्य एवं पशु संसाधन विभाग, बिहार सरकार का पत्रांक- सं.सं.-6A BASU(1)01/2025-2082 दिनांक 30.04.2026 के आलोक में बिहार पशु चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय, पटना और पशु चिकित्सा एवं पशु विज्ञान महाविद्यालय, किशनगंज के बी.बी. एस-सी. एण्ड ए.एच. तथा मत्स्यकी महाविद्यालय, किशनगंज के बी.एफ.एस-सी. पाठ्यक्रम के प्रथम वर्ष में प्रवेश हेतु अभ्यर्थियों की काउन्सेलिंग राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर National Testing Agency (NTA) द्वारा आयोजित NEET (UG)-2026 की मेधा- सूची के अनुसार राज्य कोटा की सीटों पर, मेधा-सह-विकल्पानुसार बिहार संयुक्त प्रवेश प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा पर्षद द्वारा किया जायेगा।

1.1 संक्षिप्त शीर्षक, विस्तार-सीमा एवं प्रारम्भ :

- (i) यह विवरण पुस्तिका “UGMAC-2026 की विवरण पुस्तिका” के नाम से जानी जायेगी ।
- (ii) इसका विस्तार सम्पूर्ण बिहार राज्य में होगा ।
- (iii) यह तुरन्त लागू होगी ।

1.2 परिभाषायें :

- (i) “पाठ्यक्रम” से अभिप्राय है स्नातक स्तर के चिकित्सा / दन्त चिकित्सा / पशु चिकित्सा / मत्स्यकी विज्ञान पाठ्यक्रम ।
- (ii) “परीक्षा” से अभिप्राय है National Testing Agency (NTA) द्वारा आयोजित NEET (UG)-2026 ।
- (iii) “पर्षद” से अभिप्राय है बिहार संयुक्त प्रवेश प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा पर्षद ।
- (iv) “सरकार” से अभिप्राय है बिहार सरकार ।
- (v) “परीक्षा नियंत्रक” से अभिप्राय है परीक्षा नियंत्रक, बिहार संयुक्त प्रवेश प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा पर्षद, जो सरकार द्वारा नियुक्त किये गये हैं ।
- (vi) “बिहार” से अभिप्राय है पुनर्गठन उपरान्त बिहार जो बिहार पुनर्गठन अधिनियम-2000 की धारा-4 (Clause 4 of Bihar Reorganisation Act-2000) के अनुसार पारिभाषित है ।
- (vii) चिकित्सा धारा से अभिप्राय :
चिकित्सा धारा से अभिप्राय है राज्य के चिकित्सा / दन्त चिकित्सा कॉलेजों के पाठ्यक्रम ।
- (viii) कृषि धारा से अभिप्राय :
कृषि धारा से अभिप्राय है राज्य के पशु चिकित्सा / मत्स्यकी महाविद्यालय के पाठ्यक्रम ।

2. संस्थान परिवर्तन :

चिकित्सा धारा एवं कृषि धारा के अन्तर्गत संस्थान परिवर्तन संबंधी सभी मामलों पर पर्षद द्वारा क्रमशः स्वास्थ्य विभाग तथा पशु एवं मत्स्य संसाधन विभाग, बिहार सरकार के निर्देशानुसार निर्णय लिया जायेगा। पर्षद का निर्णय अन्तिम होगा । उसके बाद संस्थान एवं पाठ्यक्रम परिवर्तन-संबंधी किसी भी आवेदन पर संबंधित संस्थानों/ विश्वविद्यालयों/ महाविद्यालयों के निदेशकों/ कुलपतियों/ प्राचार्यों अथवा संबंधित निदेशालयों द्वारा विचार नहीं किया जायेगा। किसी भी परिस्थिति में उनके द्वारा पर्षद के निर्णयों का अतिक्रमण नहीं किया जायेगा ।

3. आरक्षण / आरक्षण कोटि / आरक्षण नीति :

3.1 NEET (UG)-2026 की मेधा-सूची (Merit list) के आधार पर नामांकन हेतु चयन एवं आरक्षण लाभ के लिए UGMAC-2026 के Online आवेदन के निर्दिष्ट स्थान पर उसी आरक्षण कोटि को भरें जिसके लिए आपको विधिवत् जाति प्रमाण प्राप्त हो । राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर OBC (Other Backward Class) को बिहार राज्य में BC (Backward Class) एवं EBC (Extremely Backward Class) के रूप में पहचान प्राप्त है। अतः OBC के स्थान पर BC अथवा EBC जिस आरक्षण कोटि में आप आते हों उसका ही उल्लेख करें ।

3.2 जो आवेदक बिहार राज्य के मूल निवासी हों और जिन्हें बिहार सरकार के वांछित पदाधिकारी से आरक्षण लाभ के लिये उचित जाति प्रमाण-पत्र प्राप्त हो, उनके लिये प्रत्येक संस्थान की सीटों पर नामांकन हेतु उपरोक्त कडिका-3.1 के आलोक में आवंटन के लिए बिहार

सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित आरक्षण नीति के अनुसार विभिन्न कोटियों के लिये आरक्षण निम्नवत हैं:-

शेष 40 % अनारक्षित सीटें सामान्य कोटि (Unreserved Category : UR) की होगी।

नोट - (i) * आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर वर्ग के लिए 10 प्रतिशत आरक्षण बिहार सरकार द्वारा प्रकाशित असाधारण अंक गजट (संख्या- पटना 284) पटना, दिनांक 26.02.2019 के अनुसार होगा।

(ii) सामान्य प्रशासन विभाग, बिहार, पटना के संकल्प ज्ञापक-12722 दिनांक 12.09.2014 के आलोक में किन्नर / कोथी / तृतीय लिंग / ट्रांसजेन्डर व्यक्तियों को पिछड़े वर्गों को मिलने वाले आरक्षण का लाभ देय होगा।

(iii) बिहार स्वास्थ्य विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम-2021 की कंडिका-8 में उल्लेखित प्रावधान के आलोक में बिहार राज्य अंतर्गत शैक्षणिक संस्थानों में नामांकन हेतु समय-समय पर लागू उर्ध्वांचर आरक्षण के प्रावधानों को अक्षुण्ण रखते हुए विश्वविद्यालय से संबद्ध प्रत्येक संस्थान एवं महाविद्यालय में पाठ्यक्रमवार एवं कोटिवार कुल सीटों का एक तिहाई महिला अभ्यर्थियों के नामांकन के लिए क्षैतिज रूप से आरक्षित रहेगी। स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम में यह आरक्षण राज्य स्तर पर विशेषज्ञतावार लागू होगा।

परन्तु यह कि इस लाभ के लिए केवल बिहार राज्य की निवासी महिलायें ही पात्र होगी। योग्य महिला अभ्यर्थियों की अनुपलब्धता की स्थिति में उसी शैक्षणिक सत्र में रिक्त सीटों को संगत कोटि (आरक्षित / गैर आरक्षित) के पुरुष अभ्यर्थियों से भरा जा सकेगा। इन प्रावधानों को लागू करने हेतु सरकार द्वारा समय-समय पर यथोपेक्षित आदेश निर्गत किया जा सकेगा।

3.3 जो आवेदक बिहार के मूल निवासी नहीं हैं, वे बिहार राज्य के संस्थानों में आरक्षण कोटियों के लिये कर्णांकित सीटों पर नामांकन हेतु सामान्य प्रशासन विभाग, बिहार सरकार के अनुसार पात्रता-प्राप्त नहीं होंगे।

3.4 NEET (UG)-2026 की मेधा-सूची (Merit list) में अंकित कोटि एवं बिहार सरकार द्वारा तदनुसार निर्गत SC/ST/EBC/BC की सूची जो कॉउन्सेलिंग हेतु Online आवेदन की प्रक्रिया आरम्भ करने की तिथि तक लागू की गयी तथा जिसके लिए जाति प्रमाण पत्र विधिवत प्राप्त हो, उसी के आधार पर ही आरक्षण हेतु कोटि (Category) मान्य होगा।

NEET (UG)-2026 की प्राप्त मेधासूची में अभ्यर्थी की जो आरक्षण कोटि (OBC / SC / ST) दर्ज है वही आरक्षण कोटि UGMAC-2026 के लिए मान्य होगी। OBC आरक्षण कोटि को अभ्यर्थी OBC के स्थान पर बिहार राज्य में लागू BC और EBC जो भी उनकी आरक्षण कोटि हो उसे ही भरें।

3.5 (i) आरक्षित वर्ग के वैसे अभ्यर्थी जो अपनी मेधा के आधार पर Unreserved (UR) की मेधा सूची में स्थान प्राप्त करते हैं, उन्हें Unreserved (UR) में मनोनुकूल पाठ्यक्रम / संस्थान प्राप्त नहीं होने पर, बेहतर विकल्प के लिए अपनी सम्बन्धित आरक्षण कोटि की मेधाक्रम के अनुसार पाठ्यक्रम / संस्थान के चयन का विकल्प प्राप्त हो सकेगा।

(ii) इस संदर्भ में राज्य सरकार / माननीय न्यायालय यदि कोई दिशा-निर्देश जारी करता है तो उसे विचारोपरान्त अद्यतन रूप से लागू किया जा सकता है।

(iii) निजी चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों में नामांकन हेतु इस महाविद्यालय में अनुमान्य आरक्षण व्यवस्था मान्य होगी।

3.6 दिव्यांग कोटा (Disabled Quota i.e. DQ) के अन्तर्गत आरक्षित सीटें :

3.6.1 दिव्यांगों के लिए सभी संस्थानों में कुल निर्धारित सीटों की पाँच प्रतिशत सीटें दिव्यांग कोटा के लिये आरक्षित हैं जो निर्धारित कुल सीटों की संख्या में ही सम्मिलित होंगी।

इस क्रम में नामांकन हेतु सीट आवंटन के उद्देश्य से यदि राज्य सरकार कोई अन्य आदेश, कॉउन्सेलिंग / साक्षात्कार के लिए कॉउन्सेलिंग प्रक्रिया आरम्भ करने तक जारी करती है तब उसी आदेश के अनुरूप, दिव्यांग कोटा के अन्तर्गत नामांकन में आरक्षण-प्रावधान लागू होगा।

3.6.2 दिव्यांग कोटा के अंतर्गत मेधा-सह-विकल्प के आधार पर दिव्यांग आवेदक तभी पाठ्यक्रम (MBBS / BDS) का चयन कर सकेंगे जबकि स्वीकार्य मानकों के अधीन निर्धारित दिव्यांगता के अनुरूप उनकी दिव्यांगता ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम के चयन में बाधक नहीं होगी। भारत का राजपत्र संख्या-162 E दिनांक 14.05.2019 के प्रावधानों के आलोक में डाकटरी जाँच में योग्य पाये जाने पर ही आवेदक का नामांकन हो सकेगा।

3.6.3 दिव्यांग कोटा के अभ्यर्थी UGMAC-2026 की कॉउन्सिलिंग में सम्मिलित होने के लिए अपने आवेदन पत्र में निर्धारित स्थान पर DQ (Disable Quota) अंकित करें जो NEET (UG)-2026 की मेधासूची में उनके दिव्यांग (PH) या (DQ) होने को संपुष्ट करता हो। ऐसे दिव्यांग अभ्यर्थियों को इस विवरण पुस्तिका के परिशिष्ट-(5) एवं परिशिष्ट-(6) में अंकित निर्धारित चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों / संस्थानों द्वारा Regulation on Graduate Medical Education (1997) as amended upto 14.05.2019 के आलोक में दिव्यांगता जाँच उपरान्त निर्धारित प्रपत्र (परिशिष्ट-7) में निर्गत दिव्यांगता प्रमाण पत्र अथवा NEET-UG 2026 के Information Bulletin के prescribed proforma में, UDID Card एवं Affidavit by the candidate सहित upload करना अनिवार्य है एवं नामांकन के पूर्व Documents Verification के समय मूल रूप से प्रस्तुत करना आवश्यक होगा (Annexure-C & D)।

नोट : परिशिष्ट-5, 6 एवं 7 में अंकित क्रमशः चिकित्सा संस्थानों/ दिव्यांगता मूल्यांकन बोर्ड द्वारा निर्गत दिव्यांगता प्रमाण पत्र राज्य के मेडिकल/ आयुष/ अभियंत्रण/ कृषि आदि संस्थानों में नामांकन हेतु ही मान्य होगा, अन्य किसी और प्रयोजन हेतु नहीं।

4. चिकित्सा धारा में चिकित्सा / दन्त चिकित्सा संस्थानों के पाठ्यक्रमों में उपलब्ध सीटें:

विभिन्न चिकित्सा / दन्त चिकित्सा संस्थानों में उपलब्ध सीटों की संख्या का विवरण परिशिष्ट-1 तथा परिशिष्ट-2 में दिया गया है। बिहार सरकार/ भारत सरकार द्वारा विभिन्न संस्थानों की सीटों की कुल संख्या में फेर-बदल करने पर तदनुसार जानकारी नामांकन हेतु साक्षात्कार के पूर्व दे दी जायेगी।

4.1 चिकित्सा धारा के पाठ्यक्रमों में नामांकन हेतु अतिरिक्त सूचनाएँ एवं वांछित योग्यताएँ / अर्हताएँ :-

4.2 शैक्षणिक :

(i) 10+2 / आई.एस.सी. / प्री-मेडिकल या समकक्ष परीक्षा में अंग्रेजी (भाषा और सहित्य के रूप में) भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान (बैटनी एवं जुलोजी) / वायोटेक्नोलौजी विषयों में अलग-अलग उत्तीर्ण। सामान्य वर्ग के आवेदक को भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान / वायोटेक्नोलौजी को एक साथ मिलाकर न्यूनतम 50% अंक किन्तु अनुसूचित जाति / अनुसूचित जनजाति / पिछड़े वर्ग / अत्यन्त पिछड़े वर्ग के आवेदक को भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव-विज्ञान / वायोटेक्नोलौजी को एक साथ मिलाकर 40% अंक प्राप्त होना चाहिए।

(ii) (क) उपरोक्त के अतिरिक्त NEET(UG)-2026 की परीक्षा के आधार पर बनायी गयी Unreserved (UR) में सम्मिलित अभ्यर्थियों को भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान विषयों को एक साथ मिलाकर कुल प्राप्तांक 50 % से कम नहीं होना चाहिए। अनुसूचित जाति / अनुसूचित जनजाति, पिछड़ा वर्ग एवं अत्यन्त पिछड़ा वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों को भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान / वायोटेक्नोलौजी को एक साथ मिलाकर कुल प्राप्तांक 40 % से कम नहीं होना चाहिए।

(ख) दिव्यांग अभ्यर्थियों, के लिए NEET(UG)-2026 की परीक्षा में भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान / वायोटेक्नोलौजी को एक साथ मिलाकर कुल प्राप्तांक 45 % से कम नहीं होना चाहिए। परन्तु अनुसूचित जाति (SC), अनुसूचित जनजाति (ST), पिछड़ी जाति (BC) और अत्यन्त पिछड़ी जाति (EBC) के आवेदकों की अर्हता (Eligibility), अर्हक (Qualifying) परीक्षा तथा प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा में 40 % प्राप्तांक यथावत् होगी।

(iii) उपरोक्त कॉडिका- 4(i) एवं 4(ii) के प्रावधान मेडिकल कॉउन्सिल ऑफ इन्डिया के निर्णयानुसार संशोधित / परिमार्जित की जा सकती है और वे ही प्रावधान अन्तिम रूप से मान्य होंगे।

(iv) स्वास्थ्य विभाग, बिहार सरकार के पत्र के अनुसार भविष्य में राज्य सरकार / भारत सरकार / राष्ट्रीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद / भारतीय दन्त परिषद / माननीय न्यायालय से यदि कोई आदेश / निर्देश प्राप्त होता है तो तदनुसार विचारोपरान्त कार्रवाई की जायेगी।

4.3 आयु सीमा :

MBBS / BDS पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश हेतु अभ्यर्थी की न्यूनतम आयु-सीमा NEET(UG)-2026 की परीक्षा-वर्ष की 31 दिसम्बर को 17 वर्ष होनी चाहिए। तदनुसार अभ्यर्थी की जन्म तिथि 31.12.2009 के बाद नहीं होनी चाहिए। इस सम्बन्ध में राष्ट्रीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद / राज्य सरकार के अद्यतन प्रावधान लागू होंगे।

4.4 शारीरिक :

प्रवेश के लिये चयनित अभ्यर्थियों की डाक्टरी जाँच होगी। जाँच में योग्य पाये जाने पर ही अभ्यर्थी को प्रवेश हेतु आवंटन-आदेश निर्गत होगा। इस जाँच के लिए अलग से शुल्क लगेगा।

4.5 आवासीय अर्हता :

केवल वे ही आवेदक NEET(UG)-2026 के आधार पर प्रवेश पा सकते हैं जो भारत के निवासी हैं और

I. जिनके माता-पिता बिहार के स्थायी निवासी हैं।

अथवा

II. जिनके माता-पिता बिहार में निर्बाधित शरणार्थी हैं।

अथवा

III. जिनके माता-पिता रहनेवाले दूसरे राज्य के हैं, लेकिन बिहार सरकार के कर्मचारी हैं।

अथवा

IV. जिनके माता-पिता पुनर्गठन के पूर्व बिहार सरकार के वैसे कर्मचारी हैं जिनके संवर्ग का विभाजन अभी नहीं हुआ है और जिनका पद बिहार / झारखंड राज्य में अभी भी स्थानान्तरणीय है।

अथवा

- V. जिनके माता-पिता बिहार में पदस्थापित भारत सरकार के कर्मचारी हैं या बिहार राज्य में स्थित भारत सरकार द्वारा संचालित कारखानों अथवा संस्थानों (Public Sector Undertaking of Govt. of India) के कर्मचारी हैं।

अथवा

- VII. जिनके माता-पिता राष्ट्रसंघ के कर्मचारी हैं और तत्काल बिहार में पदस्थापित हैं।

- 4.6 i. निजी चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय एवं निजी दन्त चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय में नामांकन हेतु अभ्यर्थी भारत वर्ष का निवासी होना चाहिए एवं NEET(UG)-2026 में योग्यता प्राप्त (NEET Qualified) होना चाहिए।

- ii. माननीय उच्च न्यायालय, पटना द्वारा CWJC No.12651/2025 (नेताजी सुभाष मेडिकल कॉलेज एवं अस्पताल एवं अन्य वनाम बिहार राज्य एवं अन्य सदृश्य मामले में दिनांक 17.11.2025 को पारित अंतरिम आदेश के आलोक में निजी संस्थानों द्वारा निर्धारित किये गये नामांकन शुल्क लागू रहेगा, परन्तु यह माननीय उच्च न्यायालय द्वारा इस सम्बन्ध में पारित होने वाले आदेश से अचछादित होगा।

5. कृषि धारा में बिहार पशु विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय के अंतर्गत स्नातक पशु चिकित्सा / मत्स्यिकी विज्ञान पाठ्यक्रम में नामांकन हेतु अतिरिक्त सूचनाएँ एवं वांछित योग्यताएँ / अर्हताएँ :-

- 5.1 बिहार पशु विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय के अंतर्गत स्नातक पशु चिकित्सा / मत्स्यिकी विज्ञान पाठ्यक्रम एवं कुल सीटों की संख्या परिशिष्ट-3 में देखें। इनमें यदि बिहार सरकार / भारत सरकार द्वारा कोई फेरबदल किया गया तो इसकी सूचना नामांकन के समय दे दी जायेगी।

परिशिष्ट-3 की सूचि में संस्थान एवं अतिरिक्त सीटों को जोड़ने या बदलने का अधिकार परीक्षा पर्षद / सरकार को सुरक्षित होगा।

5.2 सीट आरक्षण :

- (क) बिहार पशु चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय, पटना के बी.बी. एस-सी. एण्ड ए.एच. पाठ्यक्रम में कुल सीटों का 15 प्रतिशत अखिल भारतीय प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा के आधार पर VCI द्वारा भरी जायेगी।

- (ख) बिहार पशु चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय, पटना के B.V.Sc. & A.H. पाठ्यक्रम के शेष 85 प्रतिशत, पशु चिकित्सा एवं पशु विज्ञान महाविद्यालय, किशनगंज के B.V.Sc. & A.H. पाठ्यक्रम एवं मत्स्यिकी महाविद्यालय, किशनगंज के B.F.Sc. पाठ्यक्रम के 100 प्रतिशत सीटों पर नामांकन हेतु अभ्यर्थियों के चयन के लिए कॉउन्सेलिंग हेतु Online आवेदन submit करने की प्रक्रिया आरम्भ करने की तिथि तक बिहार सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित / लागू आरक्षण सम्बन्धी नियमों/ नीतियों का पालन किया जायेगा।

- (ग) दिव्यांग कोटा की सीटों के लिए आरक्षण एवं अर्हता सम्बन्धी प्रावधान कडिका 3.6 में देखें।

इसके अतिरिक्त MSVE Regulations 2016 के अनुसरण में निम्न प्रावधान लागू होंगे -

- (1) यदि कोई उम्मीदवार निम्नलिखित शारीरिक विकलांगताओं से ग्रस्त है, तो उन्हें पशु चिकित्सा एवं पशु पालन स्नातक डिग्री कोर्स में प्रवेश नहीं दिया जायेगा।

- i. समूची देह की निःशक्तता, जिसमें वक्ष / रीढ़ की 50 प्रतिशत से अधिक निःशक्तता शामिल हो।

- ii. पैरों में 50 प्रतिशत से अधिक निःशक्तता।

- iii. हाथों में निःशक्तता।

- iv. नेत्रहीन उम्मीदवार और वे उम्मीदवार जिनकी श्रवण शक्ति कमजोर है।

- v. प्रणामी रोगों, जैसे पेशीविकृति, इत्यादि से ग्रस्त उम्मीदवार।

- vi. ऐसी विकलांगताएँ जिनसे पशु चिकित्सक के कर्तव्य के निर्वह में बाधा आती है।

- (2) विकलांगता को विधिवत् गठित और अधिकृत मेडिकल बोर्ड द्वारा प्रमाणित कराना होगा, जिसमें कम-से-कम तीन विशेषज्ञ शामिल होने चाहिए और जिनमें से दो संबंधित विकलांगता विशेषज्ञ होने चाहिए। उम्मीदवार को स्वयं मेडिकल बोर्ड के समक्ष प्रस्तुत होना होगा। विकलांग उम्मीदवार के प्रमाण पत्र प्रस्तुत करने की तारीख से कम-से-कम तीन माह से अधिक पुराना नहीं होना चाहिए।

- (घ) (a) In case of non-availability of suitable candidates for the vacant seats for Self Financed and Ward Quota after Stray Round Counselling for admission in B.V.Sc. & A.H. / B.F.Sc. Degree programme of the University, these vacant seats of Self-Financed and ward quota shall be transferred under the State Quota Seats. Admission for these transferred seats will then be conducted through a Special Stray Round Counselling organized by BCECEB, Patna following the continuation of the reservation roster points.

5.3 अभ्यर्थियों के लिए वांछित योग्यता / अर्हताएँ :

शैक्षणिक :

- (क) 10+2 / आई.एस.-सी. या समकक्ष परीक्षा में भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान, जीव विज्ञान एवं अंग्रेजी विषयों में अलग-अलग उत्तीर्ण होना अनिवार्य है। सामान्य श्रेणी (Unreserved category) के अभ्यर्थियों को अंग्रेजी, भौतिक विज्ञान, रसायन विज्ञान एवं जीव विज्ञान विषयों को एक साथ मिलाकर कुल प्राप्तांक 50 प्रतिशत से कम नहीं होना चाहिए। अनुसूचित जाति / अनुसूचित जनजाति, पिछड़ा वर्ग एवं अत्यन्त पिछड़ा वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों को निर्धारित अंक से 5 प्रतिशत कम (47.5 प्रतिशत) से कम नहीं होना चाहिए।

- (ख) वे छात्र जिन्होंने विदेशों में शिक्षा प्राप्त की हो, और जो अब और भारत के पशु चिकित्सा कॉलेजों में प्रवेश लेना चाहते हों, उनके लिए 12वीं

कक्षा के स्तर की परीक्षा में भौतिक शास्त्र, रसायन विज्ञान, प्राणि विज्ञान/ जैव-प्रौद्योगिकी और अंग्रेजी विषयों के साथ उत्तीर्ण और इन विषयों में कुल मिलाकर 50 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करना जरूरी होगा।

(ग) Eligibility for the Self-financed and Ward Quota seats of B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. Programme.

(1) **Self Financed Seats :** Only for domicile of Bihar. All the admission shall be based on merit only and reservation policy for admission shall be as per Govt. of Bihar.

Candidates seeking admission under this category will have to fulfil all the eligibility requirements and criteria as prescribed for the admission under General Category (for B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. programme) unless specified during the admission process.

Candidates seeking admission under this category will have to pay a non-refundable security fee of Rs. 50,000/- at the time of registration for counselling. However, if a seat is allotted and the candidate completes the admission process, the amount may be refunded to the candidate.

(2) **Ward Quota Seat :** Eligibility for admission under the Ward Quota is only for wards of regular staff of the University. In addition, candidates applying under this category must meet all the eligibility criteria and requirements prescribed for admission under the General Category (for the B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. programme).

Modalities w.r.t. allotment of regular staff ward seat :

- The wards of only regular employees of Bihar Animal Science University (Teaching and Non-teaching) shall be eligible for admission in the B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. programme under the staff quota.
- Any type of further reservation shall not be applicable for admission in the B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. degree programme at B.V.C., Patna, C.O.F. Kishanganj under this quota.
- The admission shall be made only on the basis of the NEET rank . merit (as for other seats of the state quota) of the eligible candidates as per normal admission process.
- The admission in the programme shall be made after counselling, of NEET qualified eligible students, by BCECE, Patna (as for other seats of the state quota) only.
- The admission fee for students admitted under this quota shall be the same as applicable to general quota students for admission in the B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. degree programme in the university.
- All other terms and conditions shall remain the same as applicable for others seats of the state quota. The rest rules in this respect shall be applicable as per guideline of BCECE Board / NEET.

Notes : (a) Candidates admitted under Self-Financed seats shall not be eligible for Govt. of Bihar Stipend as well as Internship Allowance.
(b) Hostel facility may be provided to students admitted under Self Financed seats as per suitability and availability.

5.4 आयु सीमा :

बिहार पशु विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय, पटना के स्नातक पशु चिकित्सा / मत्स्यकी विज्ञान पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश हेतु न्यूनतम आयु 31 दिसम्बर को 17 वर्ष होनी चाहिए। तदनुसार अभ्यर्थी की जन्म तिथि 31.12.2009 के बाद नहीं होनी चाहिए और अधिकतम 25 वर्ष होनी चाहिए तदनुसार अभ्यर्थी की जन्म तिथि 31.12.2001 के पूर्व नहीं होनी चाहिए। अनुसूचित जाति/ अनुसूचित जनजाति, पिछड़ा वर्ग एवं अत्यन्त पिछड़ा वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों के अधिकतम आयु के मामले में 5 वर्ष की छूट दी जाएगी।

5.5 शारीरिक :

प्रवेश के लिए चुने गये आवेदकों की डाक्टरी जाँच होगी। जाँच में योग्य पाये जाने पर ही आवेदक को प्रवेश दिया जायेगा। इस जाँच के लिए अगल से शुल्क लगेगा।

5.6 आवासीय अर्हता :

वही नियम जो कॉडिका 4.5(i) से (vii) में उल्लेखित है।

5.7 शर्त :

पशु एवं मत्स्य संसाधन विभाग, बिहार सरकार के पत्र संख्या-1 स्था.(1) 101/2019-1381 पटना 15, दिनांक 29.01.2019 के आलोक में पशु चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय, पटना में बी.भी. एस.-सी. एण्ड ए.एच. स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेशोपरान्त एवं पाठ्यक्रम पूर्ण करने से पहले बीच में अध्ययन छोड़ने की परिस्थिति में उन्हें 3,00,000/- (तीन लाख) रुपये की छतिपूर्ति राशि विश्वविद्यालय में जमा करनी पड़ेगी। इस संदर्भ में पशु चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय, पटना में प्रवेश के समय सभी अभ्यर्थियों को जमानत-पत्र विश्वविद्यालय को जमा करना अनिवार्य होगा।

6. NEET(UG)-2026 की मेधा-सूची के आधार पर UGMAC-2026 की कॉउन्सेलिंग में सम्मिलित होने के लिए योग्यता (Eligibility), Online आवेदन की प्रक्रिया एवं कॉउन्सेलिंग शुल्क :

(i) योग्यता (Eligibility) :

NEET (UG)-2026 जो राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर NTA द्वारा आयोजित की गई है, के आधार पर प्राप्त मेधा सूची में सम्मिलित अभ्यर्थी ही UGMAC-2026 के लिए Online आवेदन करने हेतु योग्य (Eligible) है ।

(ii) UGMAC-2026 हेतु Online आवेदन की अनिवार्यता:

उपर वर्णित कौडिका-5.4 एवं 6(i) के अनुसार योग्य (Eligible) अभ्यर्थियों के लिए UGMAC-2026 के आधार पर MBBS / BDS/ BV. Sc. & AH / B.F.Sc. पाठ्यक्रमों की बिहार राज्य कोटा की सीटों पर नामांकन हेतु कॉउन्सेलिंग में सम्मिलित होने के लिए Online आवेदन करने की प्रक्रिया नीचे कौडिका-6(iii) में दी गयी है । जो अभ्यर्थी UGMAC-2026 के लिए Online आवेदन की प्रक्रिया पूरी नहीं करेंगे वे UGMAC-2026 से सम्बन्धित किसी भी कॉउन्सेलिंग में सम्मिलित नहीं हो सकेंगे एवं इस सम्बन्ध में उनका कोई भी दावा मान्य नहीं होगा।

(iii) Online आवेदन हेतु आवश्यक प्रक्रिया :

Procurement for application form, prospectus and counselling fee & security deposit :

The Prospectus of UGMAC-2026 can be downloaded from the BCECE Board's **website: bceceboard.bihar.gov.in** by clicking on the link **"UGMAC-2026"** under Prospectus Section. For filling online Application & Choice click on **"Online Portal of UGMAC-2026"** and follow the instructions as given below;

i. Step-One (Registration) :

For Registration, candidate will have to authenticate their identity by giving NEET(UG)-2026 Roll No., Candidate's Name and Date of Birth as appearing on the computer screen. After Identity / Data authentication, an OTP will be sent to candidate's registered Mobile No. and Email Address as provided during submission of NEET(UG)-2026 Application Form invited by NTA. **No request will be entertained to change / update the Mobile No. / Email Address throughout of the session before / after successful Registration.** While doing the registration for filling the online application form, he / she is also required to create password. After successful submission of the Registration details an UGMAC ID will be generated and it will be used to complete the remaining steps of the application form and will also be required for all future reference / correspondence. To complete the remaining steps of the application form candidate will have to login their account by entering their NEET(UG)-2026 Roll No. & Password and will process the further activities to duly submit their Online Application Form. The candidate must keep the password confidential, otherwise BCECE Board will not be responsible for any consequences.

ii. Step-Two (Multi-Step Application Form) :

(a) Personal Information :

After successful registration, the candidate should again **"Sign in"** to his account and thereafter complete the required entries regarding personal information appeared on the computer screen. Then click on **"Save & Continue"** button.

(b) Contact Details :

After successful completion of Personal Information candidate have to submit their Permanent and Correspondence Address as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on **"Save & Continue"** button.

(c) Educational Information :

After successful completion of Contact Details candidate have to submit their Educational Information as appeared on the computer screen. Then click on **"Save & Continue"** button.

(d) Upload Photo, Signature & Required Documents (if any) :

After successful completion of Educational Information candidate have to upload the Scanned copy of their highly contrast Colour Photograph, Signature & Required Documents (if any) at appropriate place as per the instructions provided on the computer screen. Then click on **"Save & Continue"** button. **(For further details kindly refer to the instructions uploaded on application portal regarding Photo & Signature uploading.)**

Note : It is mandatory to upload Ward quota certificate issued by the Registrar of Bihar Animal Science University, if applicable.

iii. Step-Three (Application Preview & Final Submit) :

Candidates are advised to check their entries provided in Step-1 & Step-2 of the application form and if found any anomalies, click on **"Back to Edit"** button and rectify it. After rectification click on **"Save & Continue"** button so that the entries provided by them could get updated.

If all the informations provided during filling of Online Application Form found to be OK on the preview page, click on **"Final Submit & Proceed to Payment"** button by giving the declaration and pay the Counselling Fee & Security Deposit as per instruction provided in Step-Four. If candidates does not do the final submission of the application form and payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit within prescribed date & time, then their filled up application form will get rejected, for which candidate will be himself solely responsible and no any request will be entertained regarding this.

iv. Step-Four (Payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit) :

After clicking "**Final Submit & Proceed to Payment**" button, complete the payment procedure according to instructions appeared on the computer screen regarding payment of Counselling Fee & Security Deposit. **Paid Counselling Fee is not refundable.**

Online Payment : Candidate will have to pay the Counselling Fee & Security Deposit through Online mode only i.e. Debit Card / Credit Card / Net banking / UPI, The candidate has to pay processing charge additional to Counselling Fee & Security Deposit for payment through online mode.

Candidates are advised to download their Rank Card of UGMAC-2026 by clicking the link "**Rank Card of UGMAC-2026**" by submitting their UGMAC ID and Date of Birth.
- xi. a. The candidates are required to fill up the reservation category very carefully taking into consideration the reservation policy/ rules / category as specified and applicable in the State of Bihar on the date of starting the process of online submission of the prescribed application form for UGMAC-2026. Details of Reservation Rule may be seen in Para-3 of UGMAC-2026 Prospectus.
- b. Confirmation Page (Application Form) need not to be send to Board's office, but instead this is to be made available at the time of counselling.
- c. After completing the above procedure and after the date of editing and submitting the online application form, there is no provision for any change or modification in the same.

- * Relationship to be verified by competent revenue authority officer (Tehsildar/ Government Officer). In cases of first degree relative as per point 1 and 2 in the principles laid in Anshul Tomar vs. State of MP W.P No.13393 of 2007.

Category II : Indian to NRI (Candidates who filled their category as Indian category in NEET UG form and now want to get converted to NRI category for counselling.

1. (i) These Regulations may be called the “Graduate Medical Education Regulations, (Amendment), 2019”.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the “Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997”, in Appendix “H” - Guidelines regarding admission of students with “Specified Disabilities” under the Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MBBS –shall be substituted with Appendix “H-1”.

The “Certificate of Disability” shall be issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 15th June 2017.
2. The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016)” notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 4th January 2018.
3. The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability.
4. **The term ‘Persons with Disabilities’ (PwD) is to be used instead of the term ‘Physically Handicapped’ (PH).**

The relevant excerpt from the order passed by the Hon'ble Court in W.P No. 13393 of 2007 is as under:

"1) If the mother or father of student is NRI and residing abroad ordinarily, then, either of the situations so held will be considered to be proper.

2) If the first-degree relation of the student is NRI and residing abroad ordinarily, then in such circumstances also, qua this year, should be considered eligible. It is natural that such definition would include the real brother and sister over and above the mother-father of the first-degree relation.

3) As per the definition revised by the Hon'ble Apex Court, interpretation of clause 3 thereof as not made limited but if made in a broad perspective, then, it is clear that the person who wanted to consider such student as ward (Palya), then, he be considered to be proper subject to compliance of the following conditions:

- a) He should be the nearest relation.*
- b) In the definition of the nearest relation, committee has considered following relative having blood relations.*
 - i) Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.*
 - ii) Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.*
 - iii) Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.*
 - iv) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.*
 - v) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.*

vi) *Such person should be NRI.*

c) *Such persons should ordinarily be residing abroad.*

d) **Such person should have looked after such student as the guardian of the student and evidence to that effect must have been produced before the committee by such person.**

e) **There should be affidavit with aforesaid fact.”**

Hence, the candidates applying for NRI Quota seats will have to abide/adhere with the above-mentioned eligibility criteria for participation in counselling as NRI candidate/candidature.

It is further informed to NEET aspirants for the academic year 2026 that MCC/competent authority will seek evidential proof/ legal document from the candidates as in point 3 (d) & (e) of the order, during counselling, demonstrating that the sponsor is actually Bonafide legal guardian of the candidate as per Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.

**NEW GUIDELINES FOR ISSUANCE OF NRI CERTIFICATE BY MISSIONS/
POSTS ABROAD**

1. INTRODUCTION

A Non-Resident Indian (NRI) Certificate is a document issued by Missions/ Posts abroad in favour of Indian citizens abroad for the purpose of ratification of the NRI status of the applicant for different purposes I.e.

(i) **Financial transactions** like opening bank accounts in India, investing in real estate and other assets and accessing various financial services.

(ii) **Claiming of Taxation benefits** under the Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement (DTAA) to avoid paying taxes twice in India and their country of residence.

(iii) **Educational Benefits**, which include obtaining admission for family members in Indian universities under the NRI quota, and availing benefit of schemes like DASA (Direct Admission to Students Abroad) conducted by Ministry of Education.

Seats reserved in Educational Institutions under NRI quota also includes Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIO).

(iv) **Legal Matters** for providing proof of NRI status for legal purposes, such as property transactions or inheritance claims.

(v) **Government Benefits** like availing government schemes and services designed for NRIs.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

(i) The applicant must be an Indian national with a valid Indian passport.

(ii) The applicant must have completed a period of stay of more than 182 days in the country of residence of the applicant.

3.1 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR AVAILING EDUCATIONAL BENEFIT

Criteria for admission of students under NRI quota are as follows:-

- (1) NRIs; or
- (2) Children of NRIs; or
- (3) Wards of NRIs.

‘Ward’ shall include only a ‘minor’ who is under the bonafide guardianship of a NRI. Evidence of bonafide guardianship must be produced before the Mission/ Post by such person. Simply showing that the guardian has looked after the student will not qualify relatives as guardians. An Affidavit to the effect must be produced before the Mission/ Post by such person.

It is clarified that the following categories of guardians **who are not “bonafide guardians”** as per the above definition will be excluded from the eligibility criteria for admission of students under NRI Quota:-

- (1) First degree relation of the student, including real brother and sister over and above the mother-father of the first degree relation, is NRI and residing abroad ordinarily; or
- (2) Nearest relation who considers such student as Ward, including, real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and aunt; real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt; father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother; father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother and first degree maternal and paternal cousins.

4. APPLICATION PROCESS & DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

For the purpose of issuance of NRI Certificate, the applicant has to submit an application at the Indian Mission/ Post abroad with consular jurisdiction over the place of residence of the applicant, with the following documents:

- (i) A duly filled in application in prescribed proforma, along with two colour photos of the applicant;
- (ii) Original Indian passport and photocopy of pages of the Indian passport with visas/arrival/departure immigration stamps.
- (iii) Original and a copy of Immigration Documents (PR Card, Landing Paper, Work Permit etc.) in respect of Indian passport holders.
- (iv) Copy of Proof of Address in the country of residence including, inter alia, Driving License, Photo Identity issued by the local government, Utility Bills, etc.
- (v) A letter detailing the purpose of requirement for the NRI Certificate

5. VALIDITY OF NRI CERTIFICATE

The NRI Certificates issued by Missions/ Posts will be valid for a period of one year. However, the validity of such certificates may be renewed upon production of proof of continued stay by the applicant in the country, subject to fulfillment of other conditions.

6. PROFORMA FOR NRI CERTIFICATE

A Proforma for issue of NRI Certificate is enclosed as **Annexure-A**. For OCIs being issued similar certificates as that of NRI, mentioning their OCI status (valid OCI Card with number), and without mentioning the reasons/ purpose of issue may be followed by Missions/ Posts.

7.1 Issuing of Certificates to OCI Card Holders for Educational Benefits

In such cases where similar certificates are being issued in favour of OCIs for availing of educational benefits in India, such certificates may be issued after verification of OCI Status and other details in **Annexure-B**. Passport No. and certification of period of stay may be removed, because of their irrelevance in case of PIOs/ OCIs.

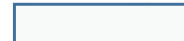

In view of the PwD Guidelines forwarded by NMC, PwBD candidates participating in UG Counselling 2026 are advised to note the following points w.r.t obtaining **Eligibility Certificate** for the purpose of upcoming NEET UG Counselling 2026, from **Medical Assessment Boards** of MCC:

1. Candidates who wish to claim seat under PwBD category are required to visit one of the **Medical Assessment Boards** of MCC (List enclosed as **Annexure-1**) and submit following documents at the board to obtain the Eligibility certificate
 - i. NEET UG 2026 score card demonstrating eligibility for the MBBS course.
 - ii. Permanent UDID card issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) (DEPwD), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, GoI.
 - iii. Self-certified affidavit declaring his or her functional abilities in the format specified in **Schedule-I** which shall be verified by Medical Assessment Board during the course of assessment.

- iv. Self-Certification **Affidavit (Appendix-A)** and Affidavit specific to the candidate's disability category, in the prescribed format of NMC as provided in **Appendix-B to F**.
2. The certificate will be generated by the center as per details of disability mentioned on the UDID card and affidavit submitted by the PwBD candidate and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria.
 3. Only those candidates who have obtained **Eligibility certificate** from a designated center of MCC will be shown choices of PwD seats.
 4. In case the UDID Card or Affidavit submitted by the candidate is found to be 'FAKE', the seat of the candidate will be 'CANCELLED'; and legal action will be taken against the candidate.
 5. The Eligibility certificate will be valid for this academic session only.
 6. Candidates who wish to avail PwBD seat under 85% State quota can visit state medical assessment boards for obtaining certificates. However, evaluation has to be conducted by the state medical assessment boards as per NMC Guidelines (2026).

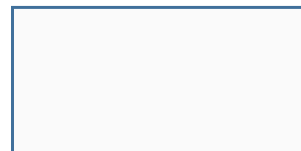
