UPDATED PROSPECTUS

As per the letter no. सं.सं.-1/प.नि.-06/2023-560(1) dated 01.08.2023 of the Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar the nominations or allotment of seats for admission in various Post Graduate Dental courses including PG Dental (MDS) shall be made according to merit-cum-choice on the basis of the Competitive Test as conducted by National Board of Examination, New Delhi i.e. NEET (MDS)-2023.

1. SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT :

- (i) This Prospectus may be called 'Post Graduate Dental Admission Counselling Prospectus-2023.
- (ii) It shall extend to the whole of the State of Bihar.
- (iii) It shall come into force at once.

2. DEFINITIONS :

- (i) 'College'—Means Dental Colleges in the State of Bihar.
- (ii) 'Course'—Means Post Graduate Dental courses of study i.e. PG Dental (MDS) Courses.
- (iii) 'Examination'— NEET (MDS)-2023.
- (iv) 'Board'— Means Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, Government of Bihar.
- (v) 'Government'— Means State Government of Bihar.
- (vi) 'Controller of Examination'- Means Controller of Examination, Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, appointed by the Government.
- (vii) 'He' includes 'She'.
- (viii) 'Bihar' - Means Bihar after reorganisation as defined under section-4 of the Bihar Reorganisation Act-2000.

3. Admission Test :

Nomination for admission in PG Dental (MDS) Courses shall be made on merit-cum-choice basis on NEET (MDS)-2023 conducted by National Board of Examination as provided in this prospectus.

4. Institutions / Available seats (MDS courses) in Govt. & Private Dental Colleges (Tentative) :

Institution / course / subject / category wise seat matrix is available as Table-1A & 1B.

- Note :**
- i. The allotments of candidates for admission against recognised seats available in Private Dental Colleges of the state of Bihar will be made.
 - ii. As against permitted seats available in Private Dental Colleges the allotment will be made subject to decision of the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and consequent directives of the Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
 - iii. The details regarding courses / institution for allotment against MDS seats of Private Dental Colleges will be made available at the time of Counselling.

- iv. For allotment of MDS seats in Private Dental Colleges, the reservation policy, as communicated by the Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar will not be applicable but instead the reservation arrangement in the concerned Institution will be applicable and the same will be made known at the time of counselling.
- v. Fee structure & other details regarding admission to MDS (Dental) courses in Private Dental Colleges will be informed by the representative of the concerned private Institutions.
- vi. Duration of MDS courses shall be of 2/3 years duration.

5. QUALIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY FOR MDS (Master of Dental Surgery) COURSE GROUP :

5.1 Educational :

- (i) The candidates must have passed the BDS Examination from any recognised Dental College of Bihar State included in the schedule of Dental Council of India. For Private Dental Colleges, this criteria is liable to be modified in the light of ज्ञापक सं.- 1/विविध-74/2016-404(1) दिनांक 06.04.2019 and related directives of Department of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
- (ii) The candidates who are permanent residents of Bihar and have been admitted in BDS course on the basis of competitive examination conducted on behalf of Govt. of Bihar or by CBSE (under All India Quota) before the bifurcation of Bihar i.e. 15.11.2000 in Dental Colleges situated in Jharkhand and have obtained the degree of BDS are also eligible for appearing in this competitive examination for admission in academic session 2023 in this Course Group.
- (iii) The candidates must have completed the rotating Internship on or before 31.03.2023 as per the provision contained in the Information bulletin of NEET(MDS)-2023.
- (iv) The candidates must have obtained Registration from Bihar State Dental Council or Dental Council of India. A candidate, who has not obtained permanent registration from Bihar State Dental Council or Dental Council of India but is otherwise eligible, may be allowed to appear at PGDAC-2023 on provisional basis but he must obtain the same within one month from the date of his admission in P.G. Dental Course as per the rules of the Dental Council of India, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled. He must also be registered after admission under the concerned University within the period prescribed by that University.

5.2 Residential :

The candidates must be a citizen of India.

5.3 Others :

A candidate who is not a permanent resident of Bihar but has passed the BDS Examination from any Dental Colleges of Bihar State included in the Schedule of Dental Council of India, is also eligible.

5.4 Age limit :

There is no maximum age limit for appearing PG Dental Counselling 2023.

5.5 No objection certificate :

A candidate who is in employment either in Government or elsewhere will be allowed to appear at the PG Dental Counselling 2023 only if he produces a certificate of "no objection" from his employer with the condition that if selected he will be granted study leave to pursue the course. However a candidate who is an employee of Government of Bihar shall be issued admit card provisionally in the absence of such "no objection" certificate. But on selection, he will have to produce relieving certificate from his controlling officer. Otherwise, he is required to furnish an undertaking/ affidavit that in case he is selected he shall resign from the service and shall undertake the studies as a full time student. Such affidavit/ undertaking is to be filed along with the application form. The relieving letter by the employer shall be submitted on or before the date of admission.

5.6 Training :

- (i) The MDS course Group Candidates called for counselling / Interview, if selected, shall have to be registered with Bihar Dental Council / Dental Council of India within one month from the date of the admission in MDS Course and will also have to be registered by the University concerned within the prescribed period by that University. The registered candidates will undergo whole time training during the entire period for completing the MDS Course.

- (ii). The compulsory Rotatory Internship must be from Institution approved and recognised by the Dental Council of India or any University duly recognised by the Government of Bihar.
- (iii). No admission or readjustment will be done after the last date of admission as fixed in compliance with the requirement of Dental Council of India. Thereafter the seats remaining vacant if any, shall be treated to have lapsed. No transfer / migration will be permissible after admission.
- (iv). An admitted candidate on the basis of counselling of PGDAC-2023 shall automatically forfeit his claim to continue in the previous MDS Course. His name registered for that MDS Course will be cancelled and upon his admission to the new MDS Course on the basis of PGDAC-2023, he will have to get registered with the university concerned for that MDS Course only and he has to refund the entire amount of stipend already paid to him for the previous MDS Course to the previous Institution and a certificate to this effect is to be produced at the time of counselling to the new MDS Course, allowed to him.
- (v). Admitted candidates who remain absent continuously for more than 2 months are liable to forfeit their candidature.

6. RESERVATION :

- (A) (i) For the selection of candidates for admission in PG Dental Course in Govt. Dental Colleges, the reservation Policy/ Rules of the Government of Bihar prevailing on the date of Online submission of Application Forms for PG Dental Counselling 2023 will be applicable.

Accordingly the reservation categories will be determined on the basis of the lists of SC, ST, EBC and BC as approved by the Govt. of Bihar and applicable on the date of the online submission of application forms for allotment of PG Dental seats on the basis of PG Dental Counselling based on NEET (MDS)-2023.

- (ii) For the Candidates, who are permanent residents of Bihar State, reservation of seats for various Categories as per the policy of the Government of Bihar prevailing at the date of PG Dental Counselling 2023 is as given below –

SN	Category	Reserved Seats (% of Total Seats)
1.	Schedule Caste (SC)	16%
2.	Schedule Tribe (ST)	01%
3.	Extremely Backward Caste (EBC)	18%
4.	Backward Caste (BC)	12%
5.	Reserved Category Girls (RCG)	03%
6.	Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10 %

The remaining 40% unreserved seats will be considered as Unreserved (UR) Category seats.

- Note : (a) 10% Reservation for Economically Weaker Section will be provided as per the Extra Ordinary Gazette of Bihar, Patna dated 26.02.2019.

- (b) Without affecting the provisions of vertical reservations, as applicable from time to time for admission in the educational Institutions in the State of Bihar, one third of total seats of all the courses and categories in each Institution and College affiliated with the University shall be horizontally reserved for admission of women candidates. In case of Post-Graduate courses it shall be applied at the State level specialty wise.

Provided that this benefit shall be available only to the women domiciled in the State of Bihar. In the absence of eligible women candidate, the vacant seats in the same academic session shall be filled up by the male candidates from the relevant category (reserved / unreserved).

- (iii) For the Candidates who are not the permanent resident of the State of Bihar, seats earmarked for the reserved categories as enumerated in Sl. No. 6(ii) above, will not be admissible, vide Department of General Administration, Government of Bihar letter no. 11/आ0-विविध-50/2011 सां- 2710 dated

26.08.2011. They will be considered against General Category seats only.

- (iv) Candidates of reserved categories competing in General Merit List will not be counted against reserved category seats. Selection of the candidates in the unreserved category will also be on merit. Placement of Reserved Category candidates will be done as per the Government resolution/ orders applicable at the time of starting the sales of the Application Form for PG Dental Counselling 2023. Candidates of reserved category competing in General Merit List will have the option for general as well as the concerned reserved category seats for purposes of placements, but the seat of reserved category exhausted due to their option will be compensated from seats of General Merit List.
- (v) A candidate claiming admission on seats reserved for SC/ ST/ EBC/ BC/ RCG will have to furnish (a) Residential certificate (b) Caste certificate from C.O. / Revenue Officer of the area of his/her permanent residence in the State of Bihar, as mentioned in the Application Form for appearing in PG DentalCounselling 2023.

N.B. :(i) Caste and Residential Certificates issued by other than C.O. / Revenue Officer will not be entertained and will lead to rejection of his/ her application.

The Residential Certificate must mention that the candidate is a permanent resident (स्थायी निवासी) of Bihar giving his complete address, letter no. and date of issue. Certificates mentioning that the candidate is resident (निवासी) / temporary resident (अस्थायी निवासी) or incomplete in any respect will not be accepted.

- (ii) Caste certificate issued on the basis of the Caste of the Husband / Wife of the candidate is not acceptable. Caste Certificate issued on the basis of the caste of his / her father will only be accepted.
- (iii) The spelling of the name of the candidate written in his application form of NEET (MDS)-2023 must be the same as written in his matriculation and other certificates. Any difference will subject to the decision of the concerned authority of the Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar.
- (vi) The category, which a candidate claims for reservation in the space provided for this purpose in the Application Form and the Residential certificate and Caste certificate which he submits as per para (v) above, will be accepted for the PG DentalCounselling 2023 and the allotment of seats will be made on that basis provided the same are in conformity with the rank list of NEET (MDS)-2023. Once the application form is accepted, no change will be allowed. In case the category claimed by a candidate and mentioned in the specified space in application form for appearing in counselling differs from that mentioned in the merit list as provided by the Deptt. of Health, Govt of Bihar based on NEET (MDS)-2023, then the category as mentioned in the Merit List will be treated as final. If a candidate does not mention the category at the specified space in application form or does not submit the proper caste certificate in support of his claim for the reserved category benefit then he will be treated in General (GEN) i.e. UR (Unreserved) category. The responsibility of losing his reservation claim due to his mistake/ carelessness will entirely be his own.

(B) Reserved Seats under Disabled Quota (DQ) :

- (a) For disabled candidates, 5% out of the available seats in each Institution, are reserved under "Disable Quota". Such reserved seats are included in the total number of the available seats.

In this connection, if the state Government issues any other Government order before publishing the merit list for counselling / interview for the purposes of the seat allotment, then reservation rules according to the same Government order, will be applicable for admission under Disable Quota subject to his DQ (or PH) status is mentioned in merit list of NEET (MDS)-2023.

- (b) Each disabled candidate is required to mention his claim in the specified space of his application form and enclose the required Disability certificate issued by a Dental Board authorised by the Government of Bihar. Such certificate must have a full size duly attested photograph of the disabled candidate, pasted there on.

- (c) A disabled candidate may opt on the basis of merit rank list of NEET (MDS)-2023, any one of such courses for which his disability is within the limits of the acceptable disability standards and is not restrictive for opting the same. The admit order will be issued to the candidate after he is found otherwise medically fit. For such medical test an additional fee will be charged.

(d) "Guidelines for admission against Disable Quota" is enclosed as Annexure - I.

7. Procurement for application form, prospectus and counselling fee & security deposit:

7.1. The Prospectus for appearing in PGDAC-2023 can be downloaded Online from the BCECE Board's website: bceceboard.bihar.gov.in by clicking on the link "**PGDAC-2023**" under Prospectus Section. For filling online Application Form click on "**Online Application portal of PGDAC-2023**" and then click on "**Apply Online**" button and follow the instructions as given below;

- I. **Step-One - Registration :** For registering, the candidates are required to fill the information asked in Step-One of the application form, appearing on the computer screen. Candidate must enter their NEET-MDS 2023 Roll No. and then click on verify button and then enter their Date of Birth and click OK to verify their details. If data gets verified then an OTP will be sent to their registered mobile no. and email ID. After verifying OTP, proceed for further process. Candidate's all informations concerning registration will be sent on their registered email ID and Mobile No. given in NEET-MDS 2023 online application form. After successful Registration, candidate will receive a message of successful registration on their registered mobile no. and email. After that, candidate will have to login to their account by entering their NEET-MDS-2023 Application no. and Password and will process the further activities to duly submit their online application form. The candidate must keep the password entered in Application Form confidential, otherwise BCECE Board will not be responsible for any changes in their data or any other complication etc. The NEET-MDS-2023 Application No. provided to the candidate by NBE will be his "user name".
- II. **Step-Two - (Personal Information) :** After successful registration and activating the account, the candidate should again "Sign in" to his account and thereafter complete the required entries regarding personal information on the computer screen. Then click on "Save & Continue" button.
- III. **Step-Three - (Upload Photo and Signature) :** After entering the personal information, the candidate should upload his / her passport size photograph as uploaded in NEET-MDS 2023 online application form and full signature in Hindi and English (Not in capital letter) after duly scanning the same. After uploading photo and signature click on "Save & Continue" button.
- IV. **Step-Four - (Educational Information) :** After uploading the scanned photo and signature the candidate should enter his / her educational information on the computer screen and click on "Save & Continue" button.
- V. **Step - Five- (Preview your application) :** After entering educational information the candidate must verify all the information given by him / her while verifying given information in step-2, step-3, step-4. If any information is found wrong, then the candidate should click "Back to Edit" button and make required corrections. Thereafter the candidate should click "Save & Continue" button so that entered information should be updated.

If preview of application form is found to be correct, then the candidate give his / her Declaration and click the "Proceed to Payment" button so that he / she should pay Counselling Fee and Security Deposit as per Step-Seven.

VI. Step-Six (Payment of Counselling Fee and Security Deposit) : After previewing the Application Form for submitting the same, candidate should click "Proceed to Payment" button and complete the payment procedure for counselling fee and security deposite according to instruction appeared on the computer screen. Counselling fee is not refundable.

- (a) Candidate has to pay Rs. 2200/-(Two Thousand Two Hundred Only) for all category as non refundable counselling/registration fee through online mode only e.g. by Credit card/Debit Card/ Net Banking / UPI.
- (b) The details of payment of security deposit for Govt. / Pvt. Dental Colleges will be as follows ;

As per above table, the candidate has to pay the refundable security deposit, if applicable, through online mode only e.g. by Credit card/Debit Card/ Net Banking / UPI at the time of registration and submission of the application form. The candidate has also to pay processing charge in addition to Counselling / Registration Fee and Security Deposit for payment through online mode.

VII. Step - Seven (Downloading of Part- A & Part-B) : After payment of Counselling/Registration Fee and Security Deposit upto scheduled date and time, the candidate must download Hard Copy (Part-A & Part-B) of online submitted Application Form and keep the same safely in his possession because it contains all informations provided by the candidate and the PGDAC-ID made available by the Board for further use during counselling.

Note : a. Hard copy of PART-A & PART-B need not to be send to Board's office, but instead this is to be made available at the time of counselling.

- b. After completing the above procedure and after the date of editing and submitting the online application form, there is no provision for any change or modification in the same.
 - c. **The candidate must note that after submission of online application form, neither it can be withdrawn nor any request for refund of paid counselling fee will be entertained.**
 - d. Board will not be responsible for any interruption in Internet / Banking system. Therefore the candidates must not wait for last date and complete all procedure before due date.
 - e. If any candidate does the payment of Counselling Fee / Security Deposit, but due to any technical issue the payment does not reflect and the amount got deducted from their bank account, then in this case candidates are advised not to wait for payment updation instead do re-payment of counselling Fee/ Security Deposit else your application form will not be accepted. Their failure transaction amount will automatically be returned back to their account within 7-8 banking working days.
 - f. Final Merit list will be prepared after scrutinising the candidate's submitted data from the data provided by National Board of Examination/ Health Deptt., Govt. of Bihar.
 - g. The Rank Card / Merit List will be published on the Board's Website on scheduled date as notified through concerned advertisement.
 - h. No other chance will be given to any candidate for Registration and submission of online application after due date for online submission of application.
4. (i) After online submission of application, if the applicant finds any entries/ photo / signature uploading **error** has / have been made, then he/ she will have opportunity to edit / rectify the same on the fixed date as notified in concerned advertisement.
 - (ii) The above mentioned editing / rectification / correction opportunity will be available for only those candidates, who have successfully filled their online application form and make the payment successfully within due date.
 - (iii) For making rectification / correction / editing in online submitted application, the candidate is required to enter the NEET-MDS-2023 Application No. & Password and click on "**Sign In**" button for getting his account to login where the editing process will be carried out.
5. DQ candidates must note that they have to submit DQ certificate issued by only authorised Centres / Institutes on prescribed proforma as per para-6B (Annexure-2,3 & 4) of the prospectus of PGDAC-2023 at the time of counselling / document verification. For this, after filling and downloading the hard copy of online application form, candidates must consult any concerned authorised Medical College / Centre / Institute with the downloaded online application form for disability test for obtaining disability certificate.

Certificate issued from any other Institutes / Centres except above **will not be entertained**, for which the candidate will himself be responsible.

7.6 Submission of the Application Form :

The completed Application Form (Part-A filled in 'Online' and Part-B filled in manually) alongwith the required enclosures is to be submitted by hand personally at the time of counselling for due verification of eligibility and identity against the original certificates / documents as presented by the candidate at the time of counselling.

After due checking / verification and establishing the eligibility of the candidate appearing for the counselling, the Course / Institution will be allotted based on merit-cum-option.

8. METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION :

8.1 Merit List:

- a) Merit list of all the qualified candidate as provided by the Deptt. of Health, Govt. of Bihar based on NEET (MDS)-2023 will be the basis for PGDAC-2023.
- b) There will be four (4) round of Counselling i.e. Round-1, Round-2, Round-3 and Stray Vacancy Round.
- c) All round Counselling i.e. Round-1, Round-2, Round-3 and Stray Vacancy round will be Online.
- d) For Round-3 Online Counselling Fresh online Registration & submission of Application Form, from those candidates who have not Registered and submitted Application Form of PGDAC-2023 earlier i.e. before 1st round Counselling, will be taken. Details will be made available through concerned advertisement.

- 8.2 (i) (a) On the basis of merit list of eligible candidates, the candidates have to fill their choices online for PGDAC-2023 counselling. Please note that registration and choice filling facility will be available as per schedule published in concerned Advertisement. After completion of choice filling process, seat allotment will be published on Board's website. In case candidate is allotted a seat during 1st round seat allotment, he / she has to report physically at reporting centre for document verification. After document verification, if he is found eligible he will either take admission or go for free exit. But if he has given willingness for upgradation during downloading of 1st round provisional seat

allotment order then after document verification, he will wait for 2nd round seat allotment and his submitted document will be retained at reporting centre.

But if his choice is upgraded in Round-2, then the candidate will have to join the college on allotted seat during second round. If candidate does not join the Institution / seat allotted during 2nd round within scheduled period, his / her refundable security deposit will be forfeited.

- (b) Candidate who did not get any upgradation in Round-2 will continue to study in the same college and seat.
- (c) Fresh choice filling can be done for Round-2 & Round-3 by those candidates;
 - (i) Who completed the registration process for Round-1 / Round-2, but did not filled the choices due to any reason.
 - (ii) Who have been allotted a seat in Round-1 but has taken free exit.
 - (iii) Fresh Registration-cum-choice filling can be done for Round-2 & Round-3 by those candidates, who have not completed the registration process during earlier Rounds due to any reason.
- (d) Modification in choice filling by logging in his previous registration details can be done for Round-2 & Round-3 by those candidates;
 - (i) Who have filled the choices in Round-1 but has not been allotted any seat in Round-1.
 - (ii) Who have filled the choices in Round-1 and has been allotted seat but given his willingness of upgradation, then in such case the candidate will have the facility to Swap / Add / Up / Down their choices, but he will not have the facility to Remove / Deleted their Round-1 allotted choice from the choice list.
 - (iii) Who have filled the choices in Round-2 and has been allotted seat but given his willingness of upgradation, then in such case the candidate will have the facility to Swap / Add / Up / Down their choices, but he will not have the facility to Remove / Delete their Round-2 allotted choice from the choice list. Admitted candidates of Round-2 opting for Round-3 can do so with forfeiture of his security deposit.
- (e) Last Round will be the Stray Vacancy round. Candidates have to make Fresh Registration with security deposit and fill New Choices for this round. Candidates admitted through Round-1 & Round-2 and also candidates allotted a seat through NEET(MDS)-2023 in Round-3 anywhere in India are not eligible for this round as per NMC (MCC) guidelines.
- (f) On the basis of online choice filling of the candidate, provisional seat allotment order will be issued. Final seat allotment/admission will be subject to verification of their identity and original certificates at reporting centre fixed by the Board.
- (g) Before downloading of provisional seat allotment order, it is necessary for those candidate who want to upgrade their allotted seat, he has to give willingness for upgradation as "Yes" else "No".
- (h) If a candidate wants to avail free exit from allotted seat in round-1 of the counselling, even then he has to report at his reporting centre for document verification and submit their original documents.

For free exit the candidate has to inform the head of institution in writing, then only all his certificates will be returned. Also the seat allotted to the candidate will be declared vacant for allotment in 2nd round. Option of free exit can only be exercised after allotment of round-I till the prescribed date.  - (ii) Submission of incorrect/ false documents / informations and adoption of unfair means/ impersonation, if detected at any stage after the selection for admission at any later stage shall automatically lead to rejection of the candidature of the candidate for admission.
 - (iii) The candidates whose Roll / Name appeared in the merit list based on NEET (MDS)-2023 will have to appear in person at his own cost for scrutiny and verification of the original documents/ his identity and for Interview/ Counselling on the scheduled date and time, failing which his claim for allotment of a seat will be rejected. No.MCI-34(41)/2019-Med./112862.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Board of Governors in super-session of Medical Council of India with the previous sanction of the Central Government, hereby makes the following Regulations to further amend the “Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997”, namely: —

1. (i) These Regulations may be called the “Graduate Medical Education Regulations, (Amendment), 2019”.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the “Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997”, in Appendix “H” - Guidelines regarding admission of students with “Specified Disabilities” under the Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MBBS—shall be substituted with Appendix “H-1”.

Appendix “H - 1”

Guidelines regarding admission of students with “Specified Disabilities” under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MBBS Course.

- Note : 1. The “Certificate of Disability” shall be issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 15th June 2017.
2. The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016)” notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 4th January 2018.
3. The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability.
4. **The term ‘Persons with Disabilities’ (PwD) is to be used instead of the term ‘Physically Handicapped’ (PH).**
